Our Crest

- Our school crest was designed by the Headteacher Mr Hall who retired in 1971 from Deyes Lane County Secondary School.
- The leaping chamois is from the goat/antelope family, is swift and sure of foot and symbolises rapid and secure progress
- The interlocking T shape heraldic charges design reflect the school's co-educational approach and brickwork in the Lydiate Building
- The ballista or trebuchet was the heraldic device of the Maghull family. The name was awarded to the family in recognition of their service during the Hundred Years' War. Mr Hall chose it because of its local links and also to encourage students to aim high and overcome difficulties

Introduction

Since we opened in 1939, Deyes High School has built a long and successful history of academic excellence and community engagement. We're proud to be part of the Lydiate Learning Trust and share its vision to 'Engage, Enable and Empower' our students.

Our brand new 10,000m² three floor school building is being constructed to replace the current school and will open in Spring 2024. The second phase of the project will be completed in Spring 2025.

We aim to fundraise £500,000 to pay for a high specification school finish. This will include the purchase of new furniture including classroom desks and chairs, sports, music and ICT equipment and outside furniture. We will also upgrade our College @ Deyes sixth form building which is not part of the new build project.

Our appeal will benefit our current and future students by creating a positive learning environment which will boost motivation, engagement and learning ability. Local community groups will also benefit as they will be using our diverse facilities.

Sustainability

The new building will be net zero carbon in operation and will feature a biosolar green roof, solar panels, treble glazed windows, thermal insulation and air source heating pumps to avoid dependency on fossil fuels.

The large green site will benefit from new features including a wildlife garden, a nature trail, and a habitat area to support learning and encourage students to connect with nature to boost their wellbeing.

"My favourite feature is the biosolar roof which features plants which will produce more oxygen for the environment" Y7 student

Providing for the Community




Deyes High School is committed to playing an active role in the local community. We are committed to being a responsible neighbour and making a positive contribution to the local environment.

Throughout the new build project, we manage all site deliveries so they do not take place during school drop off and pick up times to avoid disruption on local roads.

Our new build has been designed to accommodate the needs of the local community. We have a designated community entrance and specific areas which can be hired by sports teams and other community groups including classrooms, drama studio, gym, sports hall, Multi Use Games Area and astro turf pitches and anything else you require.

Our new build will be carbon net zero to minimise our environmental impact and we're also enhancing our natural spaces with new plants, trees and a wildlife garden.
