A learning journey that inspires and motivates

Students start at Deyes High School eager, enthusiastic, and inquisitive. They go on to confidently leave school with a range of high-level qualifications and a toolkit of skills to make their way in life.

Our philosophy is to ensure the success of each student in our care by encouraging them to take ownership of their own learning experience. This is based upon a deep understanding of how individuals learn which, when combined with employing the best teaching and support staff, yields outstanding results. We also believe that academic excellence must always be based on the principles of disciplined work habits. Students are trained in establishing these habits from the outset and are provided with a range of practical and online resources to support.

Questioning and thinking are very much part of life at Deyes, stimulating and stretching minds and creating the good habits essential for success. Students are given opportunities to discuss their interests with staff who help them to match aspirations to skills they have or wish to develop by planning a personalised progression route.

Deyes High School offers pathways to success with a curriculum tailored specifically to the individual which provides a solid foundation for adulthood. We offer a very wide range of courses and option combinations for all students at all levels. Careers information, advice and guidance is extensive, with students supported at each key 'decision making' stage of their education.

Extra-curricular activities are actively promoted to ensure that students can express themselves, enhancing their confidence and social skills through sports and the arts. Students also learn how to develop their own belief systems, whilst respecting the views of others. These activities include support for the wider community which goes beyond that of our immediate locality to include regional, national and global charitable causes.

All students have access to our online learning resources which encourages independent learning, and all our teaching staff participate in regular training to ensure consistently high quality and inspirational delivery.

Beyond the classroom, individuality thrives

At Deyes High School, we work hard to nurture obvious and hidden talents and skills that each student has to offer. We provide a broad and vibrant spectrum of experiences and opportunities that allow our students to gain skills and knowledge that will last a lifetime, helping them become well-developed, confident, and responsible individuals.

We are committed to cultural, creative and leadership activities which extend the curriculum beyond the classroom. Each child is encouraged to try new things, to play and study as individuals and as teams. All the while, their academic and social skills are being stretched and refined in preparation for the world of work.

Our enrichment programme introduces a wide range of often unusual options to compliment the core academic subjects. All subject areas offer elements of 'learning beyond the school gates,' including educational visits to other countries.

Trips have included New York, Moscow, Vietnam, Naples, Berlin, Paris, and skiing in Italy. All students have the opportunity to participate in the 'World Challenge,' promoting cultural understanding and enhancing learning and global awareness. Our students participate and excel in many areas including annual school productions, music tuition, ensembles, choirs, and bands. They regularly perform locally, regionally and nationally. Deyes High School sports teams are represented at local, county and national level in many sporting areas including football, rugby, netball, athletics, tennis, basketball, gymnastics, dance, table tennis and swimming.

Many students participate in the Duke of Edinburgh award scheme at bronze, silver and gold levels.

If a student is absent from school for a pre-agreed reason, they can undertake remote learning with their classes via Microsoft Teams. Arrangements will be confirmed to parents and students in advance to ensure continuity of education.

Healthy minds and bodies

All staff at Deyes High School are committed to the mental and physical health and wellbeing of every student. We believe that a positive mindset and a healthy lifestyle are the building blocks of a fulfilling and successful future.

Our curriculum, therefore, provides every student with the knowledge and opportunities to establish lifelong habits that will ensure their physical and mental wellbeing.

Students' physical health is developed through a varied and extensive Physical Education curriculum that ensures all students partake in activities that teach them how to ensure their individual fitness, whilst developing a love of team sports. All students are introduced to new sports in order to unearth talents and to develop an openness to new experiences.

We appreciate the pressures faced by young people in modern society and deliver guidance and support designed to provide all students with the skills to respond to these pressures positively, responsibly and maturely. This advice is delivered both proactively, via our personal development curriculum, and reactively through highly effective pastoral care and coaching.

Students play an active role in the development of their own health and wellbeing. With the support of a dedicated team of staff, students lead our Health and Wellbeing Committee to discuss the issues facing young people in the 21st Century and explore creative and appropriate solutions to them.

The committee's work has influenced school policy, extracurricular provision and lunchtime menus! Our professionally trained team of Student Peer Mentors work to support both groups and individual students so that they can make a smooth transition from primary to secondary school. We have been accredited with the Healthy Schools Award and are proud of our work on nutrition, emotional health, exercise and the healthy lifestyle choices of our students.

Pastoral care that values everyone

We make pastoral care a priority and seek to ensure that all our students are provided with the support and guidance they need in order to achieve their full potential. At Deyes High School, our pupils blossom under the care of all staff, growing in personality and performance as part of a thoroughly happy community of learning.

Students are allocated to a form group and are assigned a form tutor, who offers daily support and guidance, tracking both their academic and personal development. All form groups are supported by a devoted pastoral leadership team, who work to secure positive outcomes for all students as they transition through the different key stages.

We work hard to create and sustain strong and effective partnerships with parents and carers as we believe they are an integral part of our school community. Parental input is valued and encouraged.

We offer opportunities throughout the year for parents and carers to come into school to discuss their child's progress, as well as informal opportunities and social events and use School Cloud for virtual parents' evenings appointments.

Developing leadership skills is essential and there are many opportunities for students to join the active and thriving body of student leaders across all year groups. Future Focus Groups, Peer Mentors and the Student Council play a vital role in the development of the school by promoting the views of the students as well as our school core values. They act as ambassadors for the school and are available to any students wishing to seek their support.

The pastoral and curriculum structures are further supported by an experienced Inclusion team, who liaise closely with teaching staff and external agencies to enable support where necessary. Students also benefit from a strong support network which includes a dedicated Student Reception and Student Support Services, whose door is always open. Our school ethos upholds the fundamental 'British values' at every level. We promote pupils' spiritual, moral, social, and cultural (SMSC) development through a series of dedicated lessons which are further supported by a carefully designed Relationship and Sex Education (RSE) programme of study.







Perfect partnerships that raise aspirations

At Deyes High, we have a fundamental belief that education opens doors. Our curriculum offer is designed to broaden horizons, raise aspirations, and provide inspiration. Deyes High actively seeks the experiences and expertise of the country's leading employers, performers, and intellects to enrich our students' education and enhance their career guidance and support.

In recent years, students have benefited from working with organisations such as the BBC, Formula One, Jaguar Land Rover, Kier Construction, Vinci, Siemens, NHS, Sky Sports, and the European Organization for Nuclear Research at CERN. This work has taken the form of site visits, project planning, master classes, work experience placements and guest speakers. The partnerships form a fundamental part of the school's wider career guidance and education programme that is designed to support students in pursuit of career plans and provide inspiration to those who are unsure of their future career path.

All students are coached through this pivotal decision-making process by our expert careers and employer engagement team who keep abreast of both national and regional developments. Students compile individual Career Plans from Year 7 onwards, maximising their chances of success.

Deyes High School has always placed itself at the heart of the local community. We have close partnerships with many local schools, colleges, businesses, and our residents and their contributions enhance the learning experiences of our students. Our partners provide work experience, industry expertise and assisting student enterprise activities. Everything we do is focused on helping students to achieve their absolute best to realise their aspirations.


