## Year 8: Session Information

### Kooth

This session will be provided by your Head of Years; Mr Owen and Mrs Turner

The session will be based around the launch of the new online platform we will have in school from September called 'Kooth'. XenZone is the company who has launched Kooth. They are a provider of online mental health services for children, young people and adults. Kooth, is an online counselling and emotional well-being platform which accessible through mobile, tablet and desktop and is free of charge. Kooth will be explained to you and then you will have chance to play around and explore it online.

### Police: Organised crime

This session will be delivered by Merseyside Police and their 'Organised Crime Unit'

The session will focus on what types of organised crimes are happening in the Sefton area. They will provide information as to the consequences of committing crimes and give advice in relation to how to avoid getting involved in such crimes

### Drugs Watch Foundation

This session will be provided by an external company called 'Drugs Watch Foundation

The session will be based around the concept of drugs and focus on the dangers of them and possible negative consequences of using them

### The Gang Man

This session will be provided by an external company called 'Get Away N Get Safe' and be led by its founder, James Riley who has been a Prohibition Officer in the Criminal Justice System for 18 years

The session will be based around the concept of educating, inspiring and empowering you to take control of your future by rejecting the gang lifestyle. You will receive information on what gangs do, why they are dangerous to be involved with along with some advice on what to do should you need help related to being part of a street gang
