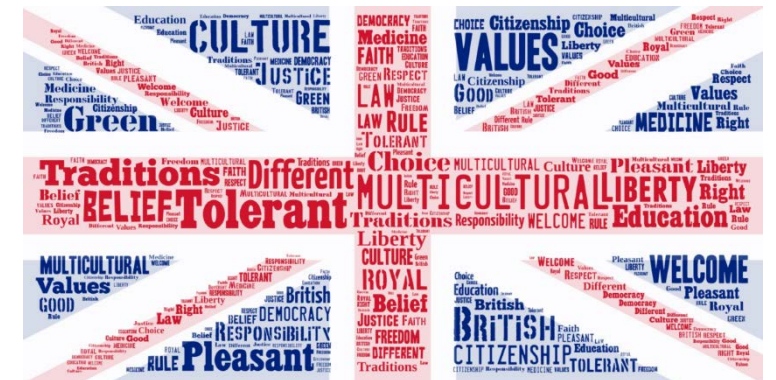


WHAT ARE THE FUNDAMENTAL BRITISH VALUES?

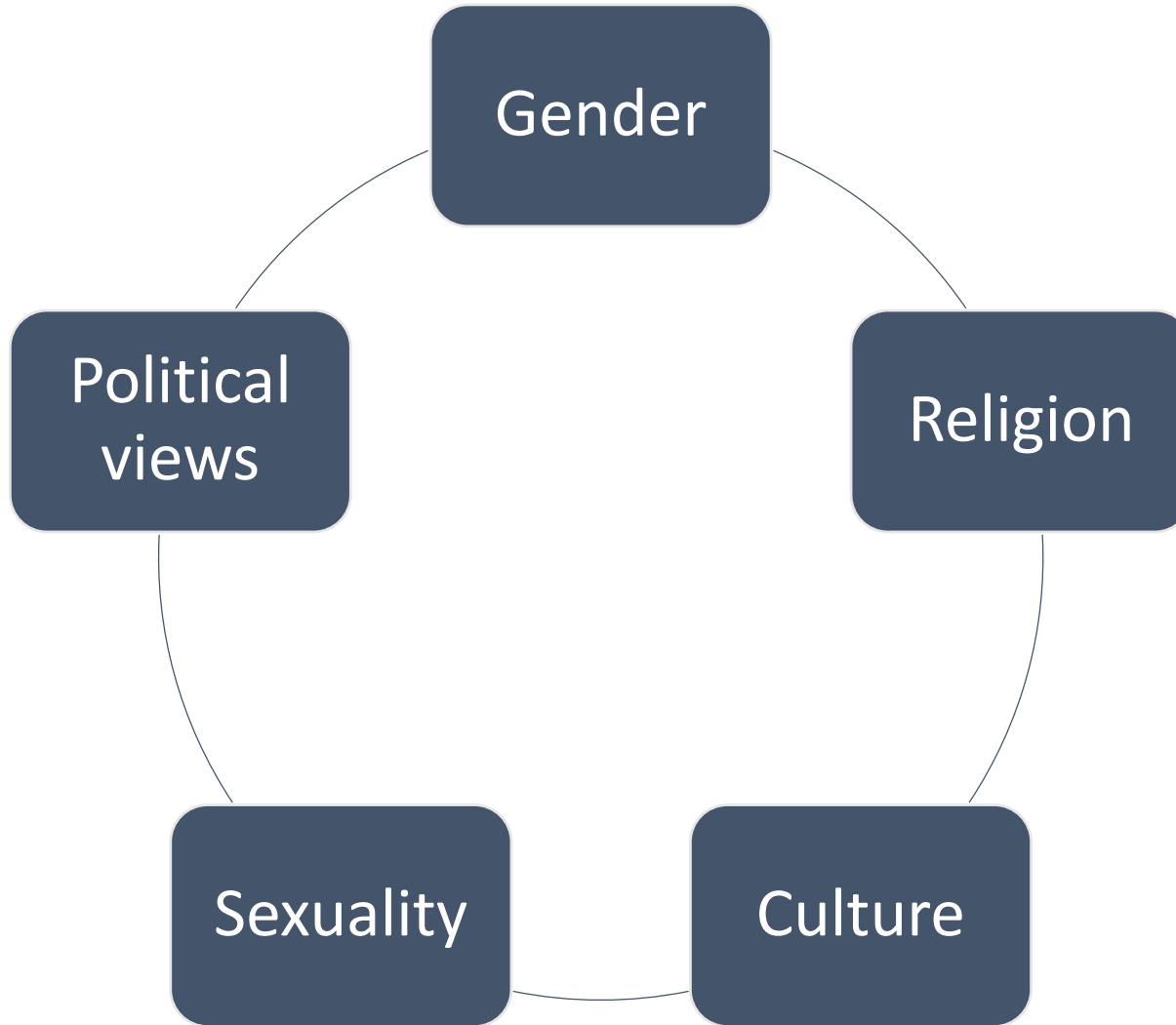
