Prologue - Tells some earlier story, and connects it to the main story- almost like an introduction

Blocking- The precise staging of actors on stage, where they enter and exit from

Tension- The development of suspense in a performance

Stage fighting- craft or fight choreography is a specialised technique in theatre designed to create the illusion of physical combat without causing harm to the performers
